Who we are in Christ: We are New Creations

Read 2 Corinthians 5: 14 – 6: 2

1. Begin by talking about your experiences of novelty. How did life change when there was a new baby in the family? Have you moved to live in a new country? What challenges did you face? What changed when you got married, or changed career?

2. What do the words 'New Creation' mean to you? Share a little of your stories of meeting Jesus and becoming New Creations. What changed? What was the old that went and the new that came?

(v. 17) Think especially around the headings:

- New Freedom
- New Point of View
- New Reconciliation
- New Ministry

3. Verse 19 says that God is reconciling the world to himself. Does this have an impact on the way we treat creation, and if so how?

4. How can we be Christ's ambassadors (v. 20) in our homes, work places and town?

5. Part of 'Transforming Ferndown for Jesus' involves reaching out to others. How does this ministry of reconciliation look? What might we as a Church do to be involved in the ministry of reconciliation?

6. What would you need to share to lead someone to Jesus so that they could experience reconciliation with God?

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
